

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# Westie Save, Spend & Share Jar Labels for the Top

The labels were designed to fit 3.25" wide mouth Mason Jars with open top lids. For best results, print the labels on a heavy cardstock.

Instructions for Label Tops.

1. Cut out the circles to fit the insides of the mason jar open top lids.
2. Cut out the gray rectangles to create a hole for the money to fit thru.
3. Place the circle on the top of the jar and screw the lid on.
4. Repeat for the other two labels.
